

ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY

You are welcome in our Centre if you:

- 1. Respect officials and their decisions and don't publicly criticise them.
- 2. Respect players and spectators from both teams.
- 3. Know the rules read and abide by the sport by-laws.
- 4. Be a good sport yourself and set a good example.
- 5. Be supportive, whether your team is winning or losing.
- **6.** Immediately and politely alert your game official or our Sports Supervisor if someone's behaviour is deemed to be anti-social.
- **7.** Discuss your concerns or issues with your team captain who can then approach your game official. Do not speak directly with anyone from the opposing team. If necessary your concern will be escalated to our Sport Supervisor.
- 8. Refrain from any behaviour that might be interpreted as 'inappropriate' according to Kwinana Recquatic Centre.

You are NOT welcome in our Centre if you:

- 1. Argue with or make derogatory remarks to or about an official.
- 2. Question an officials decision (unless you are a team captain, who must do so politely and in accordance with the rules of the game).
- 3. Use offensive body language (e.g. aggressive stares, movements) that intimidates an official or other players.
- 4. Use offensive language on or off court.
- 5. Verbally abuse, sledge or provoke others.
- 6. Use violence in any form, including bullying.
- 7. Make derogatory comments or jeer loudly.
- **8.** Confront any player, coach, game official or supporter to challenge, complain or insult.
- **9.** Do not respect the rights, dignity and worth of others, regardless of their gender, age, ability, culture or religion.

Asking someone to leave the centre is unpleasant for all concerned. Please help make our competition enjoyable for everyone!
